**REF: News Release** 

On December 19, 2025, the Lee County Narcotics Task Force executed a search warrant at a residence located at 2139 Johnson Street Road in Keokuk as part of an ongoing narcotics investigation.

During the execution of the search warrant, investigators located methamphetamine, marijuana, and drug paraphernalia consistent with the distribution and use of controlled substances. A firearm was also seized as evidence.

As a result of the investigation, the following individuals were taken into custody and transported to the Lee County Jail:

- John Dale Wyatt, age 52, of Keokuk, was charged with felon in possession of a firearm, possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, and maintaining a drug house.
- Mark Clinton Avery, age 38, of Keokuk, was charged with possession of a controlled substance second offense, delivery of controlled substance less than 5 grams, possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession of marijuana.
- Jenean Joyce Brockett, age 50, of Keokuk, was charged with possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.

This investigation remains ongoing. All subjects are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Lee County Narcotics Task Force was assisted by the Lee County Sheriff's Office, the Iowa Division of Narcotics Enforcement, the Keokuk Police Department, the Fort Madison Police Department, and the Lee County SRT Team.

The Lee County Narcotics Task Force is partially funded through the U.S. Department of Justice, with funds administered by the Iowa Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy.
