Public Health updates website to add more local resources

Henry County Public Health is pleased to announce that their website has been updated to provide more details about services they provide, additional information about important health topics, and new resource pages to help you find services in Henry County. In addition to having an online version of the Directory of Community Services guide, there are now local resource pages focused on behavioral health, food, healthcare access, and safe disposal of medicines. Health topics highlighted on the website include cancer prevention, respiratory illnesses, healthy eating, and physical activity. The home page now has dedicated space for health alerts and Public Health news and events.

“We wanted to make our website easier for people to navigate and provide more information about the services that we provide and the health topics that are of concern to our community,” states Kelly Carr, Community Outreach Coordinator. “We added the resource pages to cover some areas that we know people struggle with, such as finding health insurance or knowing who to call when someone is in crisis.”
