Becky Wilson Announces Candidacy for Henry County Attorney Special Election

WINFIELD -- Friday the Henry County Board of Supervisors voted to hold a special election to fill the recently vacated County Attorney position. Winfield attorney Becky Wilson announced she is running for the position and submitted more than the required number of signatures within hours of the vote.

Attorney Wilson has a total of 17 years of legal experience, consisting of 7 years as a NALA certified paralegal and 10 years as a practicing attorney in Iowa. She has practiced many areas of law; bankruptcy, family, personal injury, criminal defense, probate, child in need of assistance, guardianships, juvenile delinquencies, and more., She grew up in small-town Iowa and now lives in Winfield. She and her husband have been married 37 years and have three sons and two grandchildren. Her husband is pastor of the Winfield Open Bible Church.

Wilson says “Not having spent my entire life in Henry County is a plus as a candidate for Henry County attorney. After years of concerns about nepotism and favoritism in the courthouse, I am the change that Henry County needs. I do not bring a lifetime of relationships, personal loyalties, and family connections to the office that could complicate the situation when I evaluates cases.”

“Henry County deserves a prosecutor with legal experience and maturity. They deserve a choice that can restore the public’s trust in the office, to know that their interests are being placed first. I will restore these qualities to the Henry County Attorney’s Office, and will work for the interests of our communities, not my own.”

Wilson looks forward to earning the support of the voters for the special election, it could be as soon as March 31st. The Board of Supervisors will announce the date and deadlines at 11:00 on Monday February 23.
